# **MDC – Kendall Guidelines for Scholarship Awards**

- All scholarship auditions will be held with at least two faculty members present.
- The student must receive a recommendation from all adjudicators.
- All auditions should include sight reading and scales (for instrumentalists)
- Students must enroll in, and maintain, 12 credits to be/remain eligible for a scholarship.
- Students are not required to be music majors to be eligible for consideration.
- Scholarship award will be granted by unanimous consent of the adjudicators at the following levels:

## **\$200 Level I Intermediate I**

Awards at this level will be granted to an individual with a scoring of Intermediate or Competent and must perform in a minimum of two ensembles.

## **\$500 Level II Intermediate II**

Awards at this level will be granted to an individual with a scoring of Intermediate or Competent and must perform in a minimum of two ensembles.

## **\$800 Level III Artistic**

Awards at this level will be granted to an individual with a scoring of Competent or Artistic and must perform in a minimum of two ensembles.

Levels are determined by the quality of audition performance, financial situation (need, out of state tuition, etc.) and number of ensembles.
