About Accommodated Testing for Students with Disabilities

Eligibility for Testing Accommodations: Students must submit documentation of a qualifying disability to the ACCESS Disability Services to be eligible for accommodated testing.

Notification of Eligibility to the Instructor: Students with disabilities requesting testing accommodations must submit a Faculty Notification Form to inform their instructor of their eligibility. Specific details of the disability are not disclosed by ACCESS Disability Services and can only be shared by the student. In compliance with ADA, Title II, "Public entities (i.e., faculty, advisors, staff) **must refrain from making unnecessary inquiries** into a participant's disabled status." [College Procedure 4055](#)

Amount of Extended Time on Assessments: Generally, students with disabilities are eligible for double (2x) time to complete an exam, quiz, etc. If the scheduled in-class assessment time is one (1) hour, a student eligible for extended time would generally receive two (2) hours to complete the exam in a proctored setting. Please note that allotting double time to the entire class would not meet the student's accommodations. The amount of extended time is often contingent on the nature of the disability, but another factor to consider is the extent to which timeliness is of importance to the nature of the exam or program (e.g., a skills test on emergency medical procedures in a health sciences or nursing course). There are some cases where additional time would compromise the fundamental nature of the program of study. Additionally, there may be some exams where a student may require more than double (2x) time due to the nature of the students' disability and its impact on the response time.

Accommodated Testing in the Classroom, Faculty Office and/or Academic Department: Instructors opting to test students outside of the Testing and Assessment department must provide a distraction reduced setting – minimizing both visual and auditory distractions. It is important to note that all arrangements for readers, scribes, interpreters, and/or other auxiliary aids should be made through ACCESS Disability Services, which employs and schedules all auxiliary aids staff and maintains all auxiliary aid equipment and software.

Return of Testing Materials: Testing materials, along with the Faculty Testing Request Form must be delivered to and picked up from Testing and Assessment by the professor or a representative from the academic department. Professors opting for a digital return of testing materials will have a copy sent to the email provided, and physical copies of testing materials will be shredded.
